

Materials submitted to the Degree Committee following the doctoral (or master's) thesis defense

1. The first page or the full text of each published paper shall be provided, with the candidate's name highlighted.
2. Supporting documentation demonstrating the candidate's role as a primary author and major contributor shall be furnished, namely a certificate from the experiment spokesperson, physics coordinator, or analysis convenor, specifying the candidate's specific contributions to the analysis.
3. The first page of the analysis notes, supporting notes, or conference notes shall be submitted, with the candidate's name highlighted.
4. In cases where the candidate has directly submitted a manuscript to a journal and it has been accepted for publication, the acceptance letter shall be provided to clearly indicate the candidate's name.
5. All the above-mentioned materials shall be signed by the supervisor and reviewed and endorsed by the discipline head (or the responsible academic programme coordinator).
